Dear Bob:


Enclosed is a picture of our Oliver C-5 near Harper, Ks. This unit is producing 70 barreis per day with a 45/25 oil to water cut, from the "Hertha" zone of the K.C.-Lansing series at 3658 feet. We are running the engine at 475 RPM and using about 6 BHP.

Bruce and I have traced this engine back to the Schrock C-1 (completed 10-22-82) and that is as far as we can go. It has a cast iron base, no name plate, but we have modernized it, with a Thermo-Syphon cooling system and an Impco carbuetor.

We went back to 1-1-89 and added up our expenses for the last six years, it was \$1,508.42 dollars, including the new radiator, oil, anti-freeze and labor. Thats about \$251. dollars a year, 69 cents a day and if anyone can beat that-I'll throw in with them. We have less down time than our ranch owners.

We just thought you might like a "Certified" engine report to celebrate the 40 and 80th. birthdays. Just keep building them like that one- OK?
